The impression made by the Band program in the community and larger public is of great concern to the NPBB and its staff. Parent volunteers & chaperones often form that impression on behalf of the Band Program.

One of the goals of CSCSHC is to provide the safest environment possible of all students. This requires any volunteer working directly with students to complete the SAFE VISITOR SOLUTIONS Volunteer Background Check.
