Honolulu, Hawaii King Kamehameha Parade

JUNE 9 – 15, 2020

ALOHA!

Take a trip June 9-15, 2020 to Honolulu, Hawaii and perform in the 104th Annual King Kamehameha Parade in one of the world's most beautiful playgrounds on the island of Oahu, Hawaii.

Oahu's nickname, The Gathering Place, is an apt one. The island is the hub of the aloha state, home to more than 80 percent of the state's population and the major gateway to the Neighbor Islands. Honolulu, the state capital and business center, and nearby Waikiki, the legendary beach resort with its nonstop action, give Oahu its cosmopolitan flair.

Yet, Honolulu and Waikiki remain surrounded by stunning natural beauty. The island's splendid Waianae Mountains in the west rise 4,000 feet above sea level, while the green Ko'olau range crossing the middle of Oahu rises to heights of more than 3,000 feet. Pineapple plantations dot the center of Oahu, scores of beach parks are found along the island's coastline and the world-famous North Shore surfing communities wind along the northern edge of the island.

DAY ONE | TUESDAY, JUNE 9, 2020

TRAVEL DAY

- Departing flights from Indianapolis to the beautiful island paradise of Oahu, Hawaii
- Traditional fresh flower lei greeting upon arrival
- Hotel Check-in
- Dinner and free time in Waikiki – on own
- Check into your hotel for your five-night stay

DAY TWO | WEDNESDAY, JUNE 10, 2020

BEACH TIME AT WAIKIKI BEACH

- Buffet Breakfast – included
- Free time on Waikiki Beach (on own). No one should travel all the way to Hawaii without spending time at world-famous Waikiki Beach. Set along Oahu's sunny, dry southern coast, it has been drawing tourists since the early 1900s. With the famous Diamond Head marking its eastern border, Waikiki is a haven for surfing, sailing, canoeing, snorkeling, kayaking, swimming and sunbathing. We're sure that everyone will find a way to enjoy their day! Waikiki also has shopping galore for trinkets, T-shirts and Hawaiian memorabilia. The famous International Market Place is within walking distance.

DAY THREE | THURSDAY, JUNE 11, 2020

PEARL HARBOR

- Buffet Breakfast – included
- Transfer via motorcoaches to Pearl Harbor. Today you will visit the USS Arizona Memorial before taking the short trip to Ford Island. Operated by the National Park Service, the USS Arizona Memorial at Pearl Harbor commemorates the U.S. Navy and Marine personnel who died in the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor on Dec. 7, 1941. Your visit includes the viewing of a 22-minute historical film and a ranger-guided boat trip to the 184-foot memorial, Arizona.
- While on Ford Island, you will perform at the Battleship Missouri Memorial (pending acceptance by the Parks Department), have an included lunch and time to tour the Battleship. Pearl Harbor is one of Oahu's most-visited attractions and is a legacy of its World War II history.

- Dinner is included at Hard Rock Cafe (or similar)
- Return to the hotel

DAY FOUR | FRIDAY, JUNE 12, 2020

OAHU ISLAND TOUR / BEACH BBQ

- Meet the motor coaches for a full day touring the Island of Oahu. You are off to experience spectacular Oahu scenery on this tour of the island. Enjoy sights such as Hanauma Bay, Diamond Head, the Blow Hole, the North Shore and the Pali Lookout. - Enjoy an authentic Hawaiian Luau, including dinner tonight. Take in the rich cultural heritage of the Pacific islands. Enjoy the spectacular Polynesian show delivered to you at the ocean's edge, under the stars and palm trees. Be touched by the magic of ancient Hawaii and all its splendor. Feel the spirit of Aloha, experience a Backyard-style Hawaiian Luau and discover why this Luau is "too good to miss."

DAY SIX | SUNDAY, JUNE 14, 2020

WAIKIKI BEACH & DEPARTURE

- Before spending your last day, in Hawaii, at the beach, breakfast buffet is included.
- The group will need to check out of their rooms by 11:00 am but a designated boys, girls, and adult room will be supplied for changing before flying home.
